

Write a Ruby class called `Twitter` that can be used as follows:

```
y = Twitter.new('Yoda')
o = Twitter.new('Obi-Wan Kenobi')
v = Twitter.new('Darth Vader')
p = Twitter.new('Padmé Amidala')

p.follow(v)
v.follow(p).follow(y).follow(v)

y.tweet 'Do or do not. There is no try.'
o.tweet 'The Force will be with you, always.'
v.tweet 'I find your lack of faith disturbing.'
o.tweet 'In my experience, there\'s no such thing as luck.'
y.tweet 'Truly wonderful, the mind of a child is.'
p.tweet 'I will not condone a course of action that will lead us to war.'
```

The `Twitter` class implements the *observer patter*. The expected output from the previous code should be:

```
Darth Vader received a tweet from Yoda: Do or do not. There is no try.
Padmé Amidala received a tweet from Darth Vader: I find your lack of faith disturbing.
Darth Vader received a tweet from Darth Vader: I find your lack of faith disturbing.
Darth Vader received a tweet from Yoda: Truly wonderful, the mind of a child is.
Darth Vader received a tweet from Padmé Amidala: I will not condone a course of action that
will lead us to war.
```
